SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 5,
L.D. 11, Bill, "AN ACT to Prohibit Smoking at Public Meetings."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of subsection 2
and inserting in its place the following:


'2. Public proceedings defined. The term "public
proceedings" as used in this section shall mean the trans-
actions of any functions affecting any or all citizens of
the State, the Legislature, its committees and subcommittees
and any board or commission of any state agency or authority.'

Further amend the amendment by inserting at the end
the following:

'5. Conditions where smoking in public proceedings are
permitted. Smoking at a public proceeding shall be allowed
provided all members present have given their consent for
others to smoke.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to redefine the
term "public proceeding." It also sets out conditions where
smoking in public proceedings is permitted.
