COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A' to H.P. 6, L.D. 12, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Payment for Sales in Retail Stores under the Liquor Laws. '

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following: '§751-A. Payment for sales in retail stores

For the purpose of receiving payment at the check-out counters for the sale of malt liquor or table wine in retail stores, the age of such employee receiving the payment shall not be under 17 16 years of age, provided that in any event an employee who is 18 years of age or older is present in the retail store in a supervisory capacity.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to lower from 17 to 16 the age of a minor receiving payment for beer or wine in a retail store.
