STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Payment for Sales in Retail Stores under the Liquor Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

28 MRSA § **751-A**, as last amended by PL 1971, c. 598, § 60, is further amended to read:

§ 751-A. Payment for sales in retail stores

For the purpose of receiving payment at the check-out counters for the sale of malt liquor or table wine in retail stores, the age of such employee receiving the payment shall not be under 17 years of age, the employee receiving the payment may be a minor, provided that in any event an employee who is 18 years of age or older is present in the retail store in a supervisory capacity.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit persons who are minors to ring up sales for malt liquor and table wine in supermarket check-out counters providing a supervisor age 18 or older is present in the retail store.
