SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 39,
L.D. 25, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Deer Hunting with Muzzle-loading
Rifles."

Amend the Amendment by inserting before the Fiscal Note
the following:

'§2526. Wearing apparel during muzzle-loading rifle deer season

Any person hunting deer during the muzzle-loading rifle
deer season shall, during any time which he is so hunting, wear
either:

A. Clothing which is a replica of the uniform worn by
minutemen during the American Revolution; or

B. Buckskin shirt and trousers.

Any person who shall wear the hunting apparel set out in
paragraph A shall, during any time which he is hunting, be accompanied
by a person beating a drum.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to define the wearing
apparel which must be worn during the muzzle-loading deer hunting
season.
