Amend the Amendment by inserting at the end of subsection
10 of that part designated "§2355-F." the following underlined blocked
paragraph:

'The commissioner shall use at least 1/2, or \$85,000, whichever
is smaller, of the revenue generated by moose permits and
application fees for moose research and management.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that a portion of the revenue
generated by the experimental moose season is used for moose
research and management.
