SENATE AMENDMENT"A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT"A" to S.P. 42, L.D. 28, Bill, "AN ACT to Test an Open Season on Moose for a One-year Period."

Amend the amendment on page 2 by striking out all of the last sentence of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'There shall be a fee of \$3 for designating a subpermittee, this fee to accompany the \$10 fee of the hunter.'

Further amend the amendment on page 2 by inserting after subsection 6 the following:

'6-A. Pursuing wounded moose. No permittee or subpermittee shall pursue, outside the hunting district, any wounded moose shot within the district, unless that permittee or subpermittee is accompanied by an inland fisheries and wildlife warden.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide a \$3 fee for subpermittee hunting with a permit holder. The amendment also provides that hunters who wound a moose within the hunting district may not track or trail the wounded moose outside of the district unless accompanied by a game warden.
