**AN ACT to Require the Secretary of State to Give Notification when the Renewal
of Motor Vehicle Registrations are Due.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 106-B is enacted to read:

§ 106-B. Notification of expiration

The Secretary of State or his designee shall notify any holder of a motor vehicle registration, which is due to expire, of the date of that expiration. This notification shall be sent no more than 60 days nor less than 30 days before the expiration date of the holder's registration. In addition to the fee for registration required under section 242, the Secretary of State may require payment at the time of registration of an additional fee sufficient to cover the cost of preparing, processing and mailing notification of expiration under this section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would require that the Secretary of State notify persons when their motor vehicle registrations will expire. The notice will be given between 30 and 60 days prior to the expiration. The cost of this notification would be covered by a notification fee to be paid at the time of registration.
