COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 57, L.D. 66. Bill, "AN ACT to Change the Date on Which the Annual Sessions of the County Commissioners are Held in Sagadahoc County."

Amend the Bill in the Title by striking out the words "in Sagadahoc County"

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'30 MRSA §151, as amended by PL 1969, c. 99, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

§151. Sessions: times; places

The county commissioners shall hold sessions in the shire town of each county at least 3 times annually in 3 different months and at other times or other places which they may designate.'

## Statement of Fact

This committee amendment repeals the law requiring county commissioners of the various counties to meet at specific times during the year. The replacement statute proposed here merely requires the commissioners to meet at least 3 times in different months, leaving specific dates to the commissioners.
