**AN ACT to Change the Date on Which the Annual Sessions of the County
Commissioners are Held in Sagadahoc County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 151, 13th ¶ is amended to read:

Sagadahoc, on the ~~first~~ **2nd** Tuesdays of March, July and November;

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to move the date of the commissioners' meetings in Sagadahoc County from the first Tuesday of March, July and November to the 2nd Tuesday of those months. By moving this date, the county commissioners will avoid double billing, late payments to creditors and the crush of preparing warrants and monthly reports when the first Tuesday falls early in the month. By holding sessions on the 2nd Tuesday, the earliest meeting date will be the 8th, as opposed to a possible meeting date on the first of the month. All prior month's bills and reports should be in hand by the 8th, thus permitting a more efficient handling of business.
