HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 61, L.D. 69, Bill, "AN ACT to Repeal Certain Requirements for Filing, Recording, Registers, Rosters and Binding and Provisions Concerning Administrative Assistant to the Chief Justice."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 3 the following:

'Sec. 3-A. 4 MRSA §55, first sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1977, c. 114, §1, is amended to read:


The clerk of the Supreme Judicial Court shall preserve ~~3-~~  
2 complete sets of briefs filed in all cases in the Supreme Judicial Court sitting as the law court.

Sec. 3-B. 4 MRSA §55, 3rd sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1977, c. 114, §1, is amended to read:

One set each shall thereupon be delivered to the law libraries respectively of Cumberland and Penobscot Counties ~~and to the State Law Library~~ for preservation and reference.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to reduce the cost of preserving briefs of the law court. The State Law and Legislative Reference Library, by request, is provided single copies of all law court briefs for preservation and reference and doesn't need or want the bound volumes.
