HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 82,  
L.D. 93, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Requirements for Registration  
of Professional Foresters."

Amend the Amendment in the 13th and 14th lines after the  
title by striking out the words "graduate of a school of forestry  
recognized by the board" and inserting in their place the  
following: '~~graduate-of-a-school-of-forestry-recognized-by-the  
board~~ person'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that any person  
may practice forestry under the supervision of a registered  
forester. This will prevent technicians from losing their jobs,  
as they would under the present bill.
