**AN ACT to Increase the Permissible State Discount to State Agency Stores to 12%  
Under the Alcoholic Beverages Statutes.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

28 MRSA § 204, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 771, § 302, is further amended by adding after the 2nd sentence the following:

**The commission shall sell to special agency stores established under section 153, spirituous and vinous liquor, except table wine, for a price of 12% less than the retail price established for the state retail store where the purchase is made, provided that this discount shall not apply to federal taxes levied on or after November 1, 1941.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill permits special agency stores to purchase liquor from state liquor stores for a 12% discount, excluding taxes.
