AN ACT Concerning Fees for Special License Plates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 192, 2nd ¶, first sentence, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 589, § 5, is further amended to read:

The registration plates so provided shall be issued only upon application therefor, and upon payment of ~~an annual~~ a service fee of \$10.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Presently people with special "vanity" license plates pay an annual service fee of \$10 in addition to the regular \$15 registration fee.

This bill would make the \$10 service fee a one-time fee.
