AN ACT to Increase Salaries of Elected Officials of Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 30 MRSA § 2, sub-§ 1, ¶ O, as repealed and replaced by PL 1977, c. 67, § 3, is amended to read:

O. Washington County:

(1) Commissioners

(a) Chairman	\$3,000	\$3,300.00
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(b) Members	2,500	2,750.00
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(2) Treasurer	6,885	7,573.50
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(3) Sheriff	12,500	13,750.00
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(4) Judge of probate	7,800	8,580.00
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(5) Register of probate	7,721	8,493.10
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(6) Register of deeds	7,721	8,493.10
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Sec. 2. Retroactivity. This bill shall be retroactive to January 1, 1979.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill increases by 10% the salaries of the following Washington County officials: The county commissioners, the county treasurer, the sheriff, the judge of probate, the register of probate and the register of deeds. The increase would be retroactive to January 1, 1979.
