COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 103, L.D. 113, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Revise the Statute Relating to the Removal of  
Dangerous Buildings."

Amend the Bill in section 6 in that part designated  
"§2856." by inserting at the end 2 underlined sentences to  
read:

'If a building is secured under this section, notice, in  
accordance with section 2851, subsection 1, shall be given.  
This notice need not be given before securing the structure if  
the threat to the public health and safety requires prompt  
action.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require notice to be  
given if a municipality, in an emergency, must immediately secure  
a building. This notice need not be given before securing the  
building, if the emergency demands prompt action.
