HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to  
H.P. 102, L.D. 122, Bill, "AN ACT Permitting Binding  
Arbitration for Public Employees in Critical Public Services."

Amend the amendment on page 2 by inserting in subsection 1,  
before the last blocked paragraph, the following new paragraph:

'In addition to the penalties in this subsection, a fine of  
\$100 shall be levied for each day the organization is in  
violation of section 1651.'

The purpose of this amendment is to provide penalties  
for illegal strikes by employees subject to binding  
arbitration.
