HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 102, L.D. 122, Bill, "AN ACT
Permitting Binding Arbitration for Public Employees in
Critical Public Services."

Amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out all of
paragraphs C and D of subsection 2-B and inserting in their
place the following:

- 'C. Municipal ambulance and rescue services;
- D. Direct care services in municipal hospitals; and
- E. Police personnel described under section 1024,
subsection 1, paragraph F.'
