COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 97, L.D. 124, Bill, "AN ACT to Dissolve Membership of the Towns of Hope and Appleton from the Community School District."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 8 the following:

'Sec. 9. Computation of state-local allocations. The Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services is authorized to prorate expenditures made by the Appleton-Hope Community School District for the purpose of determining state-local allocations for the respective towns.'

- Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services to prorate the expenditures of the community school district in order to determine the allocations for the member towns.
