COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 124, L.D. 131, Bill,
"AN ACT to Increase the Mileage Reimbursement and Compensation
of Jurors."

Amend the Bill in the Title by striking out the words "and Compensation"

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'§1215. Mileage and compensation of jurors

A juror shall be paid mileage-at-the-rate-of-log-per-mile for his actual travel expenses from-his-residence-to-the-place of-holding-court-and-return, including mileage at the same rate as state employees under Title 5, section 8, and shall be compensated at the rate of \$20 for each day of required attendance at sessions of the court.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

This amendment sets the mileage reimbursement for jurors at the same rate as that for state employees and provides an appropriation to cover that additional cost.
