COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 121, L.D. 138, Bill, "AN
ACT Concerning Remedies under the Unfair Trade Practices Statutes."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting
clause and inserting in its place the following:

'5 MRSA §213, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1973, c. 788, §13,
is further amended by adding at the end the following new
sentence:

There shall be a right to trial by jury in any action brought
under this section.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment restores "restitution" as the remedy in
private actions and expressly provides for the right to a jury
trial in any private action under the Unfair Trade Practices Act.
