COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 147, L.D. 150, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Revise the Service Charge for Local Vehicle  
Registration Agents."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the  
amending clause and inserting in its place the following:  
'The agents may charge any applicant a fee not to exceed \$1 over  
and above the required registration fee for each renewal  
issued and a fee not to exceed \$2 in the case of each new  
registration issued, the service charges to be retained by the  
municipality.'

Fiscal Note

This bill has no financial effect on State Government, but  
may increase fees to municipalities providing this service.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow municipal  
agents to charge additional fees of less than \$1 or \$2 for  
motor vehicle registration. The bill requires that a municipal  
agent charge an additional \$1 or \$2 or nothing at all.
