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**AN ACT to Revise the Statute Providing Reimbursement to Municipalities for Revenue Loss Due to Certain Personal Property Tax Exemptions.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. 30 MRSA § 5056, sub-§ 2, ¶ C**, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 98, § 7, is amended to read:

**C.** For the year 1979-80, **and each year thereafter**, 50% of each municipality's revenue loss shall be reimbursed.

**Sec. 2. 30 MRSA § 5056, sub-§ 2, ¶¶ D-G**, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 98, § 7, are repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make the inventory tax exemption consistent with the 1978 constitutional amendment providing for 50% state reimbursement of any state-mandated property tax exemptions.
