STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT Concerning Coon Hunting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2455, 2nd ¶, first sentence, as last amended by 1977, c. 78, § 75, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

It shall be unlawful to hunt wild animals from $\frac{1}{2}$ hour after sunset until $\frac{1}{2}$ hour before sunrise of the following morning, except as provided in chapters 301 to 337 and except that a person may hunt raccoon between those times when the hunting is done with a .22 caliber rifle.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit persons to hunt raccoon at night when they use a .22 rifle.
