HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.
155, L.D. 194, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for a Student Member
of the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the last
underlined paragraph before the statement of fact and
inserting in its place the following:

'Any standing committee of the board of trustees,
excluding committees with responsibilities for matters of
personnel or employee relations, shall include one student
member with full voting rights. Each student member shall be a
full-time student and shall be selected by the board of
trustees in a manner prescribed by the board provided all
the student body of the greater university system is represented
and permitted input in the selection process.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for a
selection process:

1. In a manner presented by the board of trustees;
2. Involving all the student body of the greater university
system; and
3. To include input by students.
