COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 155, L.D. 194, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for a Student Member of the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'P&SL 1865, c. 532, §4, as last amended by PL 1977, c. 696, §354, is further amended by inserting at the end the following:

Any standing committee of the board of trustees, excluding committees with responsibilities for matters of personnel or employee relations, shall include one student member with full voting rights. The student members shall be full-time students and shall be selected by the board of trustees from a list submitted by the University of Maine Organization of Student Governments.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that any committee of the board of trustees, with the exception of committees dealing with personnel or employee relations, will have one student, selected by the board of trustees from a list submitted by the University's Organization of Student Governments.
