AN ACT to Clarify the Application of Military Service Credits to Retirement Benefits for Policemen, Firemen, Local District Employees, Sheriffs and Full-time Deputy Sheriffs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 MRSA § 1092, sub-§ 3, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 622, § 23, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

No military service credits provided under section 1094, subsection 13, shall be allowed in the computation of 20 to 25 years of service under this section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to clarify the inapplicability of military service credits under Title 5, section 1094, subsection 13 to the computation of special retirement benefits under Title 5, section 1092, subsection 3.
