COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 176, L.D. 210, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide an Effective Penalty Under the Labor Laws
for Violation of the Statute Requiring a Written Statement of
Reason for Termination of Employment."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending
clause and inserting in its place the following:

'An employer who fails to satisfy this request within 15 days
of receiving it may be subject to a forfeiture of not less
than \$50 nor more than \$500.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to establish a penalty
for an employer failing to provide written reasons for termination
of employment.
