COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 120, L.D. 229, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Increase the Compensation for Atlantic Sea Run  
Salmon Commission Members to \$50 a Day."

Amend the Bill in the Title by striking out the figure  
"\$50" and inserting in its place the figure '\$25'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of  
the first line after the enacting clause the underlined  
abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the last  
paragraph before the statement of fact and inserting in its  
place the following:

'2. Compensation. The appointed member shall receive  
~~\$10~~ \$25 a day and expenses when engaged in the discharge of  
his official duties.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds shall be  
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes  
of this Act.
