**AN ACT to Increase the Compensation for Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission
Members to \$50 a Day.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 6251, sub-§ 2, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 661, § 5, is amended to read:

2. **Compensation.** The appointed member shall receive ~~\$10~~ \$50 a day and expenses when engaged in the discharge of his official duties.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides a needed increase in the per diem received by members of the Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission.

Approximately 6 Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission meetings are held annually and, therefore, this would increase expenses to the commission by about \$250 annually.
