COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 182, L.D. 232, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Duties of the Commissioner of Education Relating to Bilingual Education."

Amend the Bill by striking out the title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Amend the Duties of the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services Relating to Bilingual Education.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'20 MRSA §102, sub-§16, 2nd¶, as repealed and replaced by PL 1977, c. 26, is amended to read:'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following stricken out sentence:

'If-an-emergency-situation-should-be-created-at-the-secondary level,-the-commissioner-may-give-temporary-approval-for-such programs.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to repeal an additional sentence which is inconsistent with the intent of the bill. The amendment also corrects the original title.
