STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Require that Heads of State Agencies Report to the State Auditor any Suspected Improper or Illegal Financial Activity in their Agency.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 MRSA § 244-A is enacted to read:

§ 244-A. Reports to the State Auditor

The head of any department or agency of the State who has any evidence of any improper or illegal transactions within his department or agency shall immediately report the transactions to the State Auditor.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require department and agency heads to report possible improper or illegal transactions to the State Auditor.
