Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and  
inserting in its place the following:  
'AN ACT to Clarify the Ability of the State Auditor to Seek  
the Advice of the Attorney General.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes the title of the bill to indicate  
that the State Auditor currently has the power to  
seek the advice of the Attorney General.
