**AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of Certain Oxford County Officials.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**30 MRSA § 2, sub-§ 1, ¶ I**, as amended by PL 1977, c. 657, § 9, is further amended to read:
