HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 223, L. D. 271, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Surplus Account of the Kennebec Sanitary Treatment District."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'P&SL 1971, c. 45, §15, last ¶, first sentence, as last amended by P&SL 1975, c. 128, §14, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

If a surplus exists at the end of a calendar year, it may be transferred to a surplus account which shall not exceed \$25,000 for the calendar year 1979, \$50,000 for the calendar year 1980, \$75,000 for the calendar year 1981 and \$100,000 thereafter; or 3% of the total expenditures of the district in the prior calendar year, whichever is the larger.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for a general increase in the limitation on the surplus fund provisions of the Kennebec Sanitary Treatment District law.
