**AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Move the Stanton Museum and its Collection
from Bates College to the Maine State Museum.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
