COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 235, L.D. 281, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Revise the Podiatric Practice Act."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the  
statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 4. 32 MRSA §3655, sub-§4, ¶¶B and C are amended  
to read:

B. John Doe, D.S.C. or D.P.M.;

C. John Doe, D.S.C. or D.P.M., Podiatrist (or Chiropracist).

Sec. 5. 32 MRSA §3655, sub-§5 is repealed.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit podiatrists to use the acronym "D.P.M." (Doctor of Podiatric Medicine) after their names, and to repeal explicitly an old provision concerning methods of doing business which directly conflicts with the more recently enacted Professional Service Corporation Act.
