STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES (Filing No. H-84) 109TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 235, L.D. 281, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Podiatric Practice Act."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 1-A. 32 MRSA §3601, 2nd sentence is repealed and the following enacted in its place: One of the examiners shall be chosen by a majority of the examiners to act as chairman of the examiners for a term of 2 years and the secretary-treasurer of the Board of Registration in Medicine shall act as secretary-treasurer of the examiners.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §3602, first, 2nd and 4th sentences are amended to read;

The examiners shall hold regular meetings, one in March, one in July and one in November7-upon-the-same-dates-and-at-the same-places-as-are-held-the-regular-meetings-of-the-Board-of Registration-in-Medicine and such additional meetings at such times and places as the said examiners may determine. The-Chairman-of-the-Board-of-Registration-in-Medicicine-shall One of the examiners shall be chosen by a majority of the examiners to act as chairman of the examiners <u>for a term of 2 years</u>.

Said records,-or-duplicates-thereof, shall be filed in the office of the Secretary-of-State secretary of the board and shall always

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be open to inspection during regular office hours.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment would specify that the Chairman of the Examiners of Podiatrists shall be chosen by a majority of the examiners to serve a term of 2 years.
