SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 250,
L.D. 295, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Constables and Special
Police Officers."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the last 5 lines
before the statement of fact and inserting in their place the
following:

'A constable's certificate of appointment shall state whether
or not he is allowed to carry a weapon, concealed or unconcealed,
in the performance of his duties. Any limitation regarding the
use of a weapon shall only apply at those times when the constable
is performing his duties.'
