STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Increase Certain Motor Vehicle Excise Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 1482, sub-§ 1, \PC, first \P, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 588, § 7, is further amended to read:

C. Motor vehicles. For the privilege of operating a motor vehicle upon the public ways, each motor vehicle, other than a stock race car, to be so operated shall be subject to such excise tax as follows: A sum equal to 24 mills on each dollar of the maker's list price for the first or current year of model, $17\frac{1}{2}$ mills for the 2nd year, $13\frac{1}{2}$ mills for the 3rd year, 10 mills for the 4th year, $6\frac{1}{2}$ mills for the 5th year and 4 mills for the 6th and succeeding years. The minimum tax for a motor vehicle other than bicycle with motor attached shall be \$5 \$10, for bicycle with motor attached, \$2.50 \$5. The excise tax on a stock race car shall be \$5. The maximum tax on and after the 7th year of model for an automobile, but not a bus or motorized home, shall be \$15 \$25.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to raise the minimum excise tax for motor vehicles to \$10 and for bicycles with motor attached to \$5, and to raise the maximum tax on or after the 7th year of model to \$25.

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
