COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 130, L.D. 307, Bill, "AN ACT to Base Adjustments of Retirement Allowances on Cost of Living."

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out at the end the following: "ef-4% in the actual percentage change in the <u>Consumer Price Index</u>" and inserting in their place the following: 'of 4% 4 1/2%'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 5 MRSA \$1128, sub-\$1, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1977, c.573, \$3, is amended to read:

<u>B.</u> Whenever the annual percentage change from July 1st to June 30th in the Consumer Price Index exceeds 4% <u>4 1/2%</u>, the board of trustees shall make such adjustments in the retirement allowances as necessary to reflect an annual increase or decrease of 4% <u>4 1/2%</u> and shall report that adjustment and the actual increase or decrease in the Consumer Price Index to the Legislature during the month of February of the following year.'

## Fiscal Note

The cost of increasing the 4% to 4 1/2% would be as follows:

In addition to the above appropriation and allocation, there will be a cost to the Dedicated Revenue Accounts of \$632,118 for 1979-80 and \$670,232 for 1980-81.

## Statement of Fact

This amendment merely increases the maximum cost-of-living adjustment to 4 1/2 from 4%. The original bill replaced 4% by the acutual change in the Consumer Price Index.
