COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 271, L.D. 345, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning the Transportation of Legally Killed Deer."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of paragraph D of
section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'D. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt deer with
the tag portion detached from his current hunting license.'
