AN ACT to Limit 3 Lobster Traps to One Warp in the New Meadows River North of the Basin.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 6439, sub-§ 4 is enacted to read:

4. **New Meadows River. Northerly of latitude 43°, 47' in the New Meadows River, which is a line that runs approximately from the mouth of the basin to and through the northern end of Sheep Island.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill limits lobster fishing to 3 traps on one warp in the New Meadows River north of the mouth of the basin.
