COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 173, L.D. 379, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Permit Nonreceiving Units to Approve School  
Appropriations in a Single Warrant Article."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end of section 1,  
before the period, the following underlined words:

'but the unit shall report to the commissioner the amount of  
the appropriation for the state-local allocation'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end of section  
2, before the period, the following underlined words:

'but the unit shall report to the commissioner the amount of  
the appropriation for local leeway'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to ensure that the  
amounts voted locally for the state-local allocation and  
for local leeway are reported to the commissioner. This  
information is necessary for determinations of future funding levels.
