COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 313, L.D. 381, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish Strike Penalties."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated
"§964-A." in subsection 1 by striking out all of the first
underlined sentence and inserting in its place the following:
'If a public employer alleges that a public employee or public
employee organization has violated any provisions of section 964,
subsection 2, paragraph C, the following penalties shall take
effect upon confirmation by the Maine Labor Relations Board or
a court of competent jurisdiction, that such a violation has
taken place.'

Fiscal Note

If enacted, this legislation will have a minimal financial impact on the General Fund. The Labor Relations Board should be able to absorb the additional cost in its normal operating budget.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to institute an appeal process before penalties can be levied.
