SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 316, L.D. 382, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Issuance and Renewals of Liquor Licenses."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its palce the following:

'<u>28 MRSA §252</u>, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 741, §16, is further amended by inserting after the 3rd paragraph the following new paragraph:

The municipal officers or county commissioners may require that they review all applications for renewals of liquor licenses, prior to submission to the State Liquor Commission. Final approval rests with the State Liquor 7 and all rights of appeal are maintained.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow municipalities, if they wish, to initially approve all requests for liquor license renewals. If a license is revoked, the licensee may appeal to the State Liquor Commission.
