COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 278, L.D. 387, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Funds to Subsidize Adoption of Handicapped Ch ildren."

Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, there exists a pressing need to provide adoptive homes for physically or mentally handicapped, emotionally disturbed or otherwise hard to adopt children; and

Whereas, this bill provides for a greater variety of funding sources for the subsidization of adoption; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the abbreviation first line after the enacting clause the underlined / and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act. These funds shall not lapse but shall carry forward until the purposes of this Act are accomplished.
