Amend the bill in that part designated "§1211." subsection 1, by inserting in the first sentence, after the underlined word "agent" the following: ',animal control officer'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§1211." subsection 2, by inserting in the first sentence, after the underlined word "agent" the following: ',animal control officer'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "<u>§1211.</u>" subsection 2, paragraph A, first sentence, by striking out the underlined word "<u>application</u>" and inserting in its place the following: 'diligence'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§1211." subsection 2, paragraph B, by inserting after the underlined word "application" the following: 'order'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§1211." subsection 2, paragraph D, first paragraph, by inserting after the underlined word "agent" the following: ', animal control officer'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment adds animal control officer to those who may apply for an ex parte order to take possession of an animal. The amendment makes 2 language and reference corrections.
