STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Relieve Resident Recipients of Maine State Retirement System Allowances from Maine State Income Tax on those Allowances.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § **5126**, as amended by PL 1977, c. 682, § 10, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

Also, a resident taxpayer shall be allowed to exempt from his adjusted gross income, as reported on his federal income tax return, the net amount of any allowance received from the Maine State Retirement System that was included therein.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows resident recipients of Maine State Retirement System allowances to exempt those allowances from their Maine state income tax.
