STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT to Extend Collective Bargaining Rights to Deputy Sheriffs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

26 MRSA § 962, sub-§ 7, as amended by PL 1975, c. 9, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

7. Public employer. "Public employer" means the following persons:

A. Any officer, board, commission, council, committee or other persons or body acting on behalf of any municipality or town or any subdivision thereof, or of any school, water, sewer or other district or of the Maine Turnpike Authority; and

B. The sheriff of any county but only with regard to the employment of deputy sheriffs.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill extends the right to collectively bargain to the deputy sheriffs of any county.
