STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Increase Recording Fees for the Registry of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

33 MRSA § 751, first paragraph, as repealed and replaced by PL 1977, c. 145, § 1, is amended to read:

Except as provided in Title 11, registers of deeds shall receive \$5 \$6 for the first record page and \$1 for each additional record page of each instrument or document presented for recording, unless a different fee is established as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase from \$5 to \$6 the fee received by registers of deeds for recording the first page of each instrument or document presented for recording.
